Bylaw No. 1/96

A Bylaw to License Mining Contractors and Well Drilling Contractors Pursuant to Section 213 (1) (b) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989.

THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VAL MARIE NO. 17, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation.
- 2. Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the municipality, shall before undertaking well-drilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the following license fee:
 - a. For drilling of an oil well or gas well... \$450.00
 - b. For drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information.......\$225.00
 - c. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when required to do so by the license inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
 - d. Bylaw No. 5/69 is hereby repealed.
