### **BYLAW 18-68**

### A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw "firearm" means a pistol revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, or any other thing by means of an explosive.
- 2. Subject to section 3 hereof, no person shall discharge any firearm within the Village.
- 3. The council may authorize an officer of the Village, in writing, to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit, in writing, entitling it to operate fir the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities in the Village.
- 4. No such club or organization as set out in section 3 hereof, shall operate at any time without a permit, and at the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by any municipal constable, license inspector or other authorized person.
- 5. Any person found guilty of and infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Village.
