## **Village of Val Marie**

### **BYLAW 19-68**

#### **A BYLAW RESPECTING FIREWORKS**

The Council of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

“Fireworks” means FIRECRACKER, rocket, squib or any other object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effect and does not include: paper percussion caps for toy guns:

1. Subject to section 2 hereof no person shall sell fireworks in the Village.
2. The Council may authorize a designated officer of the Village to issue to any person or persons a permit, in writing authorizing the sale in this Village of fireworks or any class thereof as may be specified in the permit, the duration of which permit may be specified therein.
3. Subject to section 4 hereof, no person shall set off, detonate, ignite, or cause to be exploded any fireworks in this Village.
4. (A) The council may authorize a designated officer of the Village to issue to any person or persons a permit, in writing, authorizing the setting off in the Village or in any part or parts of the Village, as may be specified in the permit, of fireworks or any class thereof as may be specified in the permit the duration as which permit as be specified therein.  
(B) A Permit issued under clause (a) of this section shall prescribe the conditions under which a display of fireworks or any specified class or classes thereof may be held in the Village or in any specified part or parts of the Village and no person shall conduct a display of fireworks in contravention of such prescribed conditions.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties as provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Village.
