BYLAW NO. 3-12

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE RESTRICTING LIVESTOCK, SWINE AND POULTRY WITHIN VILLAGE BOUNDARIES.

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Animal Control Bylaw..

General

1. No Person shall have or keep any livestock or swine within the Village boundaries.
2. Livestock for the annual indoor rodeo shall be exempt from the provisions of the bylaw for two (2) days prior to the event and for two (2) days after the event.
3. A limit of fifteen (15) poultry may be contained within a person's property.

Penalty

4. (1) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.
(2) The penalty for any breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.

Repeal of Previous Bylaws

5. Bylaw No. **3-90** and amending Bylaws are hereby repealed.

Coming into Force

This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day of its passing.
