# **VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE**

#### A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AND CONTROL A CEMETERY

BYLAW NO. 4-18

The Council of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the provision of of *The Municipalities Act* and subject to *The Cemeteries Act*, 1999 enacts as follows:

#### Location

1. That part of the North West quarter of section 30, township 03, range 13, west of the 3rd meridian (Blk A Plan 101706140 Ext 27 and Blk B Plan 101706151 Ext 28), in the Province of Saskatchewan, as designated by the Registrar under *The Cemeteries Act, 1999*, shall be and is hereby appropriated as a public cemetery to be called the Val Marie Community Cemetery.

#### **Interment Licence**

- 2. No burial shall be made in the Val Marie Community Cemetery unless a licence has been first obtained in accordance with this bylaw.
- 3. Upon written application therefore and upon payment of the fees hereinafter set forth, the Administrator (or other designate) of the Village of Val Marie, shall issue a licence for a burial lot for the burial of a deceased person in the cemetery.
  - 4. The following sums shall be charged for internment licences and shall be paid at the time of selection (opening/closing the grave):

Single Plot......\$50.00
Single Internment.....\$50.00

5. Every licence shall be in Form "A" as attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

# **Conditions of Internment**

- 6. No licensee of a lot shall allow any internment to be made therein for remuneration.
- 7. The licensee of a lot shall erect a proper headstone, monument, or flat field marker indicating the name of the interred at that location.
- 9. The licensee of a lot shall not install grave covers, cultivate trees, shrubs, or bushes on the lots.
- 10. More than one internment is permitted per lot however the internment fee listed above is to be paid for each internment on a lot.

#### **Pre-need Sales Contracts**

- 11. Pre-need Sales Contracts may be entered into.
- 12. All Pre-need Sales Contracts shall be in Form "B" as attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
