BYLAW NO. 7-01

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE REQUIREMENT TO PURCHASE A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PERMIT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE

The Council of the Urban Municipality of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as the Recreation Vehicle Permit Bylaw

GENERAL

- 2. Any recreational vehicle that has been occupied for two weeks or more, outside of the Village of Val Marie Campground or a licensed campground, is required to purchase a permit from the Village of Val Marie for \$250
- 3. This permit is Valid for one year from the date of purchase.
- 4. Village of Val Marie improved lot ratepayers are exempt from this permit, and are allowed to occupy or store their own recreational vehicle on or adjacent to their improved lot at no extra charge to them.
- 5. Village of Val Marie unimproved lot ratepayers are subject to the rules and regulations of this bylaw, as they do not pay taxes on improvements, and, since recreational vehicles are not subject to taxing.
- 6. A PERSON FOUND GUILTY OF AN INFRACTION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS BYLAW SHALL BE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$1,000 ANS SEIZURE OF THEIR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE, AS DETERMINED BY COUNCIL.

COMING INTO FORCE

7. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.
