BYLAW NO. 9-01

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE IMPLEMENTATION FOR OBTAINING A LICENSE TO OPERATE A CAMPGROUND WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE

The Council of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Campground Operation Bylaw

INTERPRETATION

2. "Campground" means any property that has more than one non-permanent structure or residence, such as a recreational vehicle, recreational vehicle shed, etc.

GENERAL

- 3. A License is required to operate a campground within the Village of Val Marie
- 4. To obtain a license, the Council of the Village of Val Marie must give approval to the owner of the property, upon their request.
- 5. The License fee is to be determined by the Village of Val Marie Council on case by case basis.
- 6. A PERSON FOUND GUILTY OF INFRACTION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS BYLAW SHALL BE LIABLE TO A FINE OF \$1,000.
- 7. OFFENDING RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WILL BE SEIZED AND TOWED TO AN AREA WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE THAT HAS BEEN ZONED FOR OCCUPANCY AND STORAGE OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES OR TO A LICENSED CAMPGROUND, AT THE EXPENSE OF THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE OWNER OR LANDOWNER, AS DETERMINED BY COUNCIL.

COMING INTO FORCE

8. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.
