BYLAW NO. 8-01

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE IMPLEMENTATION FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE ZONING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE

The Council of the Urban Municipality of the Village of Val Marie in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as the Recreation Vehicle Zoning Bylaw

GENERAL

- 2. A recreational vehicle can only be occupied for a period of time longer than two weeks in:
 - a. a licensed campground; or
 - b. on private property adjacent to Railway Avenue; or
 - c. on the lot located at 214 First Street South (Lot 8 Blk 5 Plan DL876)
- 3. Occupancy of recreational vehicle longer than two weeks is strictly forbidden in any other part of the Village.
- 4. A PERSON FOUND GUILT OF AN INFRACTION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS BYLAW SHALL BE LIABLE TO A FINE OF \$1,000.
- 5. THE OFFENDING RECREATIONAL VEHICLE WILL BE SEIZED AND TOWED TO AN AREA WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VAL MARIE THAT HAS BEEN ZONED FOR OCCUPANCY AND STORAGE OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AT THE EXPENSE OF THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE OWNER OR LANDOWNER, AS DETERMINED BY COUNCIL.

COMING INTO FORCE

6. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.
